#### Newsletter Article for November 2024

Dear Pilgrims,

"O give thanks to the Lord, for He is good, for his steadfast love endures forever. O give thanks to the God of gods, for his steadfast love endures forever. O give thanks to the Lord of lords, for his steadfast love endures forever." (Psalm 136:1-3)

The above verses may sound repetitive, but when you begin to repeat them over and over, you may realize as I do, that they are a great way to give thanks to the God we worship. We worship a God who comes to us in Trinity. God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit. They are not three gods, they are one. All of the explanations of the Trinity eventually break down into heresy, so it is sufficient to say that, while God is expressed in the three persons of the Trinity, we worship only one God.

During this month of November, we turn our hearts toward Thanksgiving. The writer of Psalm 136 makes it clear where our thanks are supposed to go. We give thanks to the Lord. We give thanks to God. We give thanks to the Spirit of the Lord. We have a direct object who receives our thanksgiving when we offer it. God receives our thanksgiving, and we give thanks to God for all of the ways we have been blessed.

Shouldn't we do that more than once a year? It seems to me that we are blessed regularly throughout the year, and therefore, God is worthy of thanks throughout the year. When you or a person you know is sick and gets better, do you pause and give thanks to God for the healing? I know many of us do, but if that is not a regular practice of yours, you may wish to incorporate it into your life.

When you are struggling with a significant problem and you're unsure of a solution, when suddenly, the solution presents itself almost magically, do you recognize the hand of God at work? Do you pause and give thanks that the will of the Lord was to offer a blessing to you right then?

Anna and I make a practice of thanking God for each meal we eat, even when we are eating at a restaurant,

and even when we are with others who may not have the same belief system we do. Sometimes it is a silent pause and prayer of thanksgiving, but I honestly think my body receives food more readily if I have offered thanks to God for it.

For many people, Thanksgiving is simply a chance to watch football and overindulge in a big meal with family. For others, Thanksgiving is a time to prepare for the Christmas shopping season and try to make sure to get to the stores with the best values on Friday. For others, Thanksgiving is just another day where they must depend on others for food since they cannot afford or are unable to feed themselves.

This Thanksgiving, as we pause and give thanks to the Lord for He is good, let us also take a moment to give thanks for the people who need to hear from the Lord. Give thanks for the people who depend on food charities to eat. Give thanks for the people who will overindulge and watch football because they have no idea where to focus their thanks. Give thanks for thepeople who will shop for bargains the day after Thanksgiving, because all of the people listed are children of God. All of them are people God loves. All of the people we remember today are people who are welcome to feast, not only at their own tables, but at the table of the Lord, where Jesus Christ himself offers his body and blood in the bread and wine of Holy Communion.

All of the people God has placed on this planet are people God loves, and all people are an opportunity for us to live out our mission statement; Pilgrim Lutheran Church is led by the Holy Spirit to invite EVERYONE to experience God's love and grace through life's pilgrimage of faith." And so, we give thanks. We give thanks to God for our place in God's mission, and we give thanks to God for all of the blessings we share at Pilgrim. Thanks be to God.
